- Steve H – Britain's ski trooper figures – also a 1/6 Russian anti-tank gunner fully equipped from Belgium, the two anti-tank guns were the PTRD 41 and the PTRS 41 – [see A and B below]. Also, the *DID Corp* squeeze bore anti-tank rifle 2.8 mm. [see C below]



- Alan M – 4 grenadier guards in Athol grey great coats – Welsh made.

Francois B – Russian figures in winter great coats plus 2 metal farm buildings for sale plus larger scale WWII
metal figures that sold.



- Mark H – 3 x 1/7 H.M. Armed Forces figures in winter gear – 2 Royal Marines plus a forward air controller. Note H.M. Armed Forces company has ceased operation, and the web site is frozen. Mark also had some 1/6 scale skis with cable bindings that were made in the 1970s. plus German WWII mountain troops by Airfix in a box.



- **Doug C** 2 of Britains 1990s Russian infantry in great coats plus the white goat named Snow. A note from **Alan M** that most mascots in the British Army are now named 'Baldrick' for the sidekick in the Blackadder series.
- Juan L he is working on winter military 1/6 scale scenes of 2-man teams from 6 countries stay tuned
- Morley V had a 2005 VHS tape of the Liberation of Holland and the Boys from Picton. Also, several WWII VHS tapes for sale.
- **Egor E** had a Chukchi figure from eastern most Russia. [see D below]



- Kelly H – displayed an MPC Russian in winter coat figure plus a MARX Warriors Of the World figure of an American at Valley Forge [see E below] – plus a 1/6 WWII infantry figure made from a doll and a 1984 fighting in December- Battle of Nashville figure [see M below]

 Steve A – displayed several sets including 6 German Mountain troops with skis: 12 Napoleonic retreat from Moscow figures of unknown manufacturer. Newfoundland regiment figures plus boxed sets of French artillery plus Beefeaters.



Bob T – First Bob began with a fanciful story that he did not buy anything soldier related in December. After the laughter subsided members saw that he had on display a diorama of John Jenkins winter warfare figures from the French and Indian wars. # **NOTES**

A] The PTRD-41 is an anti-tank rifle that was produced and used from early 1941 by the Soviet Red Army during World War II. It is a single-shot weapon which fires the 14.5×114 mm round, which was able to penetrate German tanks such as the Panzer III and early models of the Panzer IV. Length: 2,020 mm (79.5 in)

Designed: 1941 Action: Bolt-action Crew: 2 Manufacturer: Degtyaryov plant Muzzle velocity: 1,012 m/s (3,320 ft/s) Rate of fire: Manual - approximately 60,000 were manufactured [copied from Wikipedia]



B] The PTRS-41 was produced and used by the Soviet Union during World War II.

In the years between the World Wars, the Soviet Union began experimenting with different types of armour-piercing anti-tank cartridges. Finding the 12.7×108mm insufficient, they began development of what became the 14.5×114mm armour-piercing round. Rukavishnikov developed his anti-tank rifle M1939 to use this cartridge, but it was not successful because of some manufacturing issues. [copied from Wikipedia]

#### 2.8 cm schwere Panzerbüchse 41 (sPzB 41) or "Panzerbüchse 41"

was a German anti-tank weapon working on the squeeze bore principle. Officially classified as a heavy anti-tank rifle (German: schwere Panzerbüchse), it would be better described, and is widely referred to, as a light anti-tank gun.



#### D] Chukotka - officially the Chukotka Autonomous Okrug is the easternmost federal subject of Russia.

It is an autonomous okrug situated in the Russian Far East, and shares a border with the Republic of Sakha to the west, Magadan Oblast to the south-west, and Kamchatka Krai to the south, as well as a maritime border on the Bering Strait with the U.S. state of Alaska to the east. Anadyr is the largest town and the capital, and the easternmost settlement to have town status in Russia. Chukotka is primarily populated by ethnic Russians, Chukchi, and other indigenous peoples. It is the only autonomous okrug in Russia that is not included in, or subordinate to, another federal subject, having separated from Magadan Oblast in 1992. It is home to Lake Elgygytgyn, an impact crater lake, and Anyuyskiy, an extinct volcano. The village of Uelen is the easternmost settlement in Russia and the closest substantial settlement to the United States (Alaska). [taken from Wikipedia]



**Chukchi,** people inhabiting the north eastern most part of Siberia, the Chukotskiy (Chukotka) autonomous okrug (district) in Russia. They numbered 14,000 in the late 20th century and are divided into two chief subgroups, reindeer Chukchi and maritime Chukchi.

#### E] Louis Marx Company was an American toy manufacturer in business from 1919 to 1980.

They made many types of toys including tin toys, toy soldiers, toy guns, action figures, dolls, toy cars and model trains. Some of their notable toys are Rock'em Sock'em Robots, Big

Wheel tricycles, Disney branded dollhouses and play sets based on TV shows like Gunsmoke. Its products were often imprinted with the slogan "One of the many Marx toys, have you all of them?" [taken from Wikipedia]

# F] 10th Mountain Division – United States Army - [from Wikipedia]

The 10th Mountain Division is a light infantry division in the United States Army based at Fort Drum, New York. Formerly designated as a mountain warfare unit, the division was the only one of its size in the US military to receive specialized training for fighting in mountainous conditions. No other European company created so many different kinds of unpainted soft plastic soldiers, and few even tried such fantastic specialty items as chariots, ancient civilians, arrow-peppered Custer comrades, mini-dioramas of historic scenes, and full-scale World War II vehicles. One of the reasons Atlantic went out of business was that they were very lax in the quality control department. Thus it is possible (in about 1 set out of every 50 we sell) that you will receive an Atlantic mint-in-box set which is either "overstuffed" with extra figures, or "light" - the sealed box might not contain all the parts it is supposed to have. As our policy is not to open boxes which were sealed by the original manufacturer, you may receive bonus goods or find yourself short on Atlantic sets you purchase from us. Therefore, our policy is to say that all Atlantic sets are sold in as-is-condition and are not returnable for refund, credit or exchange. You get what you get, just as if you purchased a set from a store back in 1980. We cannot send you any parts you may find missing or damaged. Please note: Atlantic produced figures in two scales, 25mm (about 1" high) and 60mm (closer to 3").

#### M] The Battle of Nashville was a two-day battle in the Franklin-Nashville Campaign

that represented the end of large-scale fighting west of the coastal states in the American Civil War. It was fought at Nashville, Tennessee, on December 15–16, 1864, between the Confederate Army of Tennessee under Lieutenant General John Bell Hood and the Union Army of the Cumberland (Dept. of the Cumberland) (AoC) under Major General George H. Thomas. In one of the largest victories achieved by the Union Army during the war, Thomas attacked and routed Hood's army, largely destroying it as an effective fighting force. [taken from Wikipedia]
